

The Board recognizes the need to protect both the youth attending programs at the library and the adults who serve them. Toward that goal, the following requirements must be met in the presentation of youth programming.

Youth attending programming must be registered on an annual basis. Registration ensures that contact information is readily available and current in the event of an emergency. Adults registering children for programming also agree to abide by the Unattended Children Policy.

For programming presented by library staff, another adult must be in the room at all times. The adult may be another library staff member or a qualified volunteer.

For programming presented by those not employed by the library, a library staff member or a library-approved volunteer must be in the room at all times.

Children designated as having Special Needs due to physical or mental ability, disruptive behavior, emotional problems, lack of adequate attention span, incomplete social skills, etc., must be attended by a non-staff adult at all times.

Youth program room will be under constant electronic surveillance.
