Library visitors seeking local history or genealogy information will be assisted by staff using materials and resources located in the second floor Local History and Genealogy archives. Materials may be copied at the current rate.

Written requests for research will be directed to the Library's research volunteer. Research fees are \$7.50 per half hour, copier fees at the current rate, and postage. The volunteer's time is donated and all proceeds go toward the purchase of materials for the archive collection.

People requesting more detailed research may be referred to other local organizations (listed below) or historians who are willing to do research for a fee.
